

BIG JIM

Have you ever had someone in your school that was a real “bully”. If so raise your hands. Well this story is about someone just like that who would like to hit the boys in the stomach and pull the girls hair. And his name was, BIG JIM.

OK” (prepare your hand, moving it around and then make a loud noise getting ready to hit him) (Have your helper ready to run in and say) Wait, wait, he was hungry!! That’s no excuse, the rules are for all boys and girls, hungry or not, go sit down, NOT YOU the little boy, you stay here. Are you ready? How many ‘licks’? OK” (prepare your hand, moving it around and then make a loud noise getting ready to hit him) (Have your helper ready to run in and say) Wait, wait, does the chalk board have any names on it? Well, no, what do you mean? I want to take his punishment. What, you want to take his punishment? Well, there’s no names? Is that OK with you? OK, but you have to stay up here and watch. OK, are you ready? How many ‘licks’? OK (prepare your hand, moving it around and then make a loud noise getting ready to hit him). Then hit your own leg as your helper jumps up and down.

Boys and girls, who did something wrong here? That’s right, the little boy. But who received the punishment, That’s right the helper. How many rules are on the board? That’s right ten. How many commandments are in the Bible? That’s right ten. The Father in Heaven is like the teacher and we are like the little boy, because the Bible says that we have all done something wrong and sinned and we need punishment. The Bible says the punishment of sin is DEATH, spiritual death separated from God. How many of you want this?
